Who We Are:

Habitat for Humanity of Metro Denver (Habitat Metro Denver) is part of a global, nonprofit housing organization that seeks to put God's love into action by bringing people together to build homes, communities, and hope. Habitat for Humanity was founded on the conviction that everyone needs an affordable, healthy and stable place to live in dignity and safety, and that affordable housing should be a matter of conscience and action for all.

Habitat for Humanity's ReStores support Habitat's mission to build and preserve affordable homeownership opportunities in the Metro Denver area. The ReStores are home improvement outlets that sell donated building materials, home furnishings, appliances, and more at a discount to generate funds to support Habitat for Humanity.

To achieve our vision of a world where everyone has a decent place to live, Habitat Metro Denver builds, renovates and sells homes in partnership with low- and moderate-income families. The organization also works with existing low-income homeowners in formerly red-lined Denver neighborhoods to do critical home repairs. Throughout its 42-year history, Habitat Metro Denver has served more than 2,500 households and is the 8th largest producer in the Habitat U.S. network.

Core ReStore Volunteer: Dock Assistant Position Description

General Description: The Dock Assistant supports our staff and donors by unloading donations and getting them clean and priced to be sold on the floor.

Major Responsibilities:

- Become a Habitat for Humanity ambassador to our donors, customers, and daily volunteers by embracing our Cultural Blueprint
- Screen and unload donations
- Clean and price donations
- Keep the dock safe and clean
- Give donation receipts to donors
- Record donor zip codes
- Unload trucks/donations in an orderly fashion
- Lead daily volunteers on the dock and train new Core Volunteers
- Use proper radio etiquette
- Represent Habitat for Humanity in a positive and professional manner
- Be informed and up to date with current Habitat news, policies, and procedures

Time Commitment:

- Core Volunteers commit to 15 hours or more per month
- Shifts are flexible during store hours: Tuesday Saturday, 10am 6pm

Knowledge, Skills, & Abilities:

- Ability to lift 25 50 lbs
- Able to interact and communicate well with other volunteers, staff, customers, and donors
- Comfortable working in a warehouse environment
- Ability to pass background check

Training:

- Habitat Orientation
- Trainings on safety, pricing, and the moratorium list

Location: Volunteers will support the ReStore at their location of choice; Denver ReStore, Littleton ReStore, Arvada ReStore, Aurora ReStore.

Impact: Dock Assistant Volunteers are often the first interaction that donors have with Habitat for Humanity of Metro Denver. By positively engaging with the community of staff, volunteers, customers, and donors, Dock Assistants bring awareness and understanding about Habitat for Humanity to the community. They ensure that donations are received and ready to be sold on the floor, which helps keep the operations running smoothly in the store.
