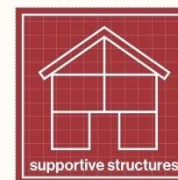
Who we are:

Habitat for Humanity of Metro Denver (Habitat Metro Denver) is part of a global, nonprofit housing organization that seeks to put God's love into action by bringing people together to build homes, communities, and hope. Habitat for Humanity was founded on the conviction that everyone needs an affordable, healthy and stable place to live in dignity and safety, and that affordable housing should be a matter of conscience and action for all.

To achieve our vision of a world where everyone has a decent place to live, Habitat Metro Denver builds, renovates and sells homes in partnership with low- and moderate-income families. The organization also works with existing low-income homeowners in formerly red-lined Denver neighborhoods to do critical home repairs. Throughout its 42-year history, Habitat Metro Denver has served more than 2,500 households and is the 8th largest producer in the Habitat U.S. network.

Overview: The Landscaping Volunteer will help upkeep the grass and plants at one of Habitat's development's detention ponds, to provide a well-kept landscape for Habitat's current homeowners and surrounding neighbors.

Major Responsibilities:

- Become a Habitat for Humanity ambassador to our community by embracing our Cultural Blueprint
- Mow grass
- Trim shrubbery and trees
- Pull weeds
- Tidy sites from debris and trash
- Other duties as assigned

Time Commitment: May – October, 4 hours every other week.

Knowledge, Skills & Abilities:

- Ability to pass background check
- Must be comfortable walking on uneven ground
- Must be able to work independently (no staff or other volunteers will be there)
- Must be able to lift 25 lbs.
- Strong communication skills
- Can bring own equipment if desired (Habitat will supply equipment as well)
- Must know how to use a lawnmower
- Must have own transportation

Training:

- Habitat Volunteer Orientation
- Tour of sites as needed

Location: Sheridan Square Development (Federal Blvd and West Kenyon Ave)

Impact: By upkeeping the lawn and plants at Habitat's past and current Construction Sites, this position will ensure that our current and future homeowners will have a well landscaped space, to benefit their homeownership.
